Post-Secondary Credit Opportunities

Seminole County Public Schools is pleased to offer our high school students with various opportunities to earn post-secondary credits while in high school. Please see the three opportunities below.

Gold Standard: Secondary to postsecondary statewide articulation agreements are based on industry certifications. Any Florida student or community member with an industry certification on the "**Gold Standard Career Pathways** Articulation Agreements of Industry Certifications list <u>here</u> is guaranteed college credit at Florida state colleges offering the specified articulated programs.

Career Pathways: Also, **Career Pathways** is a cooperative effort between local state colleges and SCPS that allows students to prepare for college and a career. The pathways are available in more than a dozen high school disciplines and are tied to career programs at these local institutions.

Dual Enrollment: Finally, **career and academic dual enrollment** opportunities are available for your student in the various CTE programs.
