Application Information

To be Eligible for the Oviedo High School PTSA 2020-2021 Scholarship, an applicant MUST:

- 1) Be a 2020-2021 student member of the PTSA as of December 1, 2020
- 2) Be a 2021 graduating Senior at Oviedo High School
- 3) GPA of 2.5 or higher (unweighted)
- 4) Show proof of acceptance at a school for continuing education, college, vocational school or community college
- 5) Submit completed application to Oviedo High School Guidance, Marcia Lightsey, **no later than Friday March 5, 2021.** Applications submitted after this date WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- ** Please note that the applicant's Discipline Record will be taken into consideration to determine Scholarship Eligibility **

How to apply:

- 1) Type or print application. Answer all questions.
- 2) Enclose the following items:
 - a) Completed application
 - b) Letter of Acceptance from college or vocational school
 - c) Essay, maximum 500 words
 - d) One letter of reference

Enclose only the above information (no transcripts) in a manila envelope and return to Marcia Lightsey in OHS Guidance office **no later than Friday March 5, 2021.**

Value of Scholarship:

Up to 12 scholarships, each in the amount of \$500, may be awarded and the scholarship value will be based on available OHS PTSA funds.

Scholarship Award:

The scholarships will be awarded on Senior Night 2021.
