Kyra has won 1st place in Science the past 4 years at the State level and the past 3 years at the National level. ## **Athletics from Athletic Director Jen Darty and Assistant Athletic Director Bill Bronga**

Track competed in the Lake Mary Opening Classic and had multiple athletes record personal bests. Both the Boys and Girls teams had excellent performances. Tristan Washington was victorious in the 100m dash with a time of 10.99 as the only runner under 11 seconds and placed 5<sup>th</sup> overall in the 400m. Bryson Blanford placed 6<sup>th</sup> overall in the Shot-put with a throw of 35'-5". Lexi Vecchiarelli won the long Jump, Alyssa Wahl and Josie Harshbarger placed 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> respectively in the 400m hurdles. Olivia Jacobus and Maya Cabal placed 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> in the 800m. Marc McDonald set a personal record while placing 6<sup>th</sup> overall in the 1600m.

Girls Varsity Lacrosse beat Edgewood 12-8, led by junior Payton Pagan with 4 goals and senior Carly O'Donnell with 3 goals and 4 assists. Junior goalie Paige Prete led the defense with 7 saves.
