ACCESS for ELLs, FSA, FSAA, EOCs

- If a student has testing accommodations on his/her plan (IEP, 504) or through their ESOL program (ELL Students), to use in the classroom, the same accommodations are available for the test.
- No further action is required by the parent or student.

Grades 3 - 12



INDUSTRY CERTIFICATONS

- Each industry certification test provider has its own process to apply for the use of accommodations, if allowable.
- Check with the classroom teacher to access information to apply for testing accommodations.

Grades 6 - 12



COLLEGE BOARD AP, PSAT, SAT

- If a student has testing accommodations in his/her plan or meets the requirements for accommodations as an ELL student, parents/guardians must sign the consent, and the school will **APPLY** for accommodations.
- **College Board will approve or deny accommodation requests and send decisions to students via USPS. Decisions usually take 7 weeks.**
- Once approved, there is no need to reapply unless the student is an ELL or receiving SAA (State Allowed Accomodations), which is done each year.

Grades 9 - 12



ACT

- If a student has testing accommodations in their plan or meets the requirements for accommodations as an ELL student, parents/guardians must sign consent, and the school will **APPLY** for accommodations.
- **ACT will approve or deny accommodation requests and notify the school. Decisions may take several weeks.**
- To receive accommodations unlike College Board, once registered* for a test, students must be associated to the test date by the school **for every administration** .
- ELL student accommodations expire on July 31 of the approval year. A new application will be required each year.
