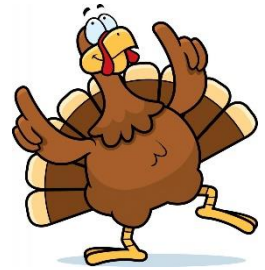

Athletics from Athletic Director Jen Darty

Varsity Football won over Hagerty, 26-18, to hold on to the Mayor's Cup for the sixth year in a row! Kage Johnson & Tim Benedick had 2 sacks each. Dallas Johnson had 2 interceptions. Jackson LaTour had 4 touchdown passes, DJ Scott had 2 touchdown receptions, and Marquet Williams & Ryan Monroe each had a touchdown reception. The team finishes the regular season with a 9-1 record and will host the Region Quarterfinal playoff game on Friday night vs. Wharton.

Girls & Boys Cross Country completed successful seasons on Saturday at the State Championships in Tallahassee. The Girls ran their way to a 13th place finish after coming in ranked 24th. Maya Cabal, Hannah Adamson, Courtney Calhoun, Hannah Atwell, Madalyn Falk, Loren Blumenfeld, Alyssa Wahl and Lillian Johnson all contributed to the effort. The Boys team finished 24th and complete the season ranked in the top 15 in Florida. Marc McDonald, Robert Bellamy, James Unwin, Aiden Aysun Brody Aysun, Colin Aysun, Myles Egerton and Yaniel Petrovich all had great seasons. Graduating only two seniors, Marc McDonald and Robert Bellamy, both teams will begin highly ranked next year. Congratulations to both Boys & Girls Cross Country and Coach Hazera on a great season!

Swimming & Diving concluded their season at the State Championship on Saturday in Stuart. Both Boys & Girls squads ended the season undefeated in dual meet competition with a 9-0 dual meet record and a 21-0 record including the LBHS Invite including being the 2022 SAC Conference Champs, District Champs, and Region Champs. At the State Meet, the Girls finished as State Runner-Up and the Boys finished 4th place overall. Congratulations to Sarah Beth Cathcart who finished as a State Champion in the 50 Free & broke the school record! Kaylin Herbet finished as State Runner-Up in the 100 Free, also capturing a school record. Marin Rose took 3rd, Gabby Goodwin is a State Finalist in the 200 & the 500, and Tessa Sims is a State Finalist in the 1-meter Diving. The Relay team of Ciel Senabria, Marin Rose, Sarah Beth Cathcart & Kaylin Herbet took a Runner-Up finish in the 200 Free Relay along with Marin Rose, Gabby Goodwin, Kaylin Herbet, & Sarah Beth Cathcart as a Runner-Up in the 400-Free Relay. Other top finishers for the Girls are Megan Hurley as a finalist in the 200 & 500 Free and Addie Borowsky & Nelle James as Finalist in the 200 Medley Relay. For the Boys, Luca Oliva finished as State Runner-Up in the 200 IM and broke a school record, Diver Carson Powers is a State Finalist with a 4th place finish in 1-meter Diving, Thomas Youngblood, Daniel Strumidlo, Ryan Walker, Jeremiah Goodwin are all individual State Finalist, along with Simon Gong, Lance Kochmann, and Tristan Massey who are also Finalist in the Medley Relays. And a special mention to Divers Molly Connell and Chloe Dunn for competing in the 1-meter Diving. Congratulations to Boys & Girls Swimming and Coach Rose on a great season!

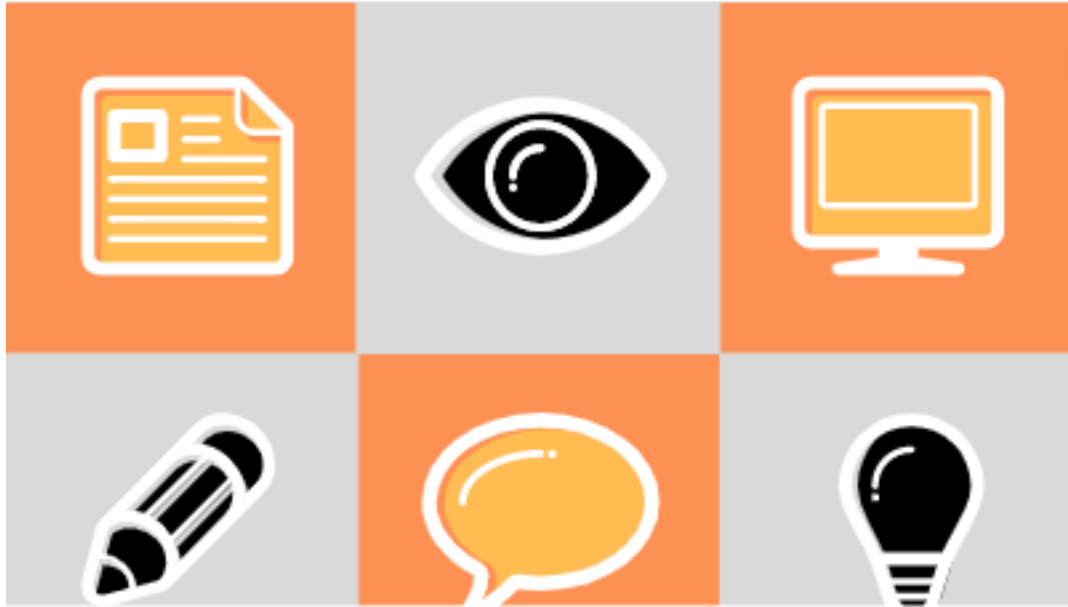
