We are excited to announce Coach Gavin McGuckin as our new Head Boys Lacrosse Coach! Coach McGuckin has previously served as a volunteer coach at Oviedo High School and is

excited to take over the program. McGuckin played Division 1 Lacrosse at the University of Massachusetts Lowell as an LSM and Close Defenseman as well as on the Wales National Team. He has worked closely and been mentored by Rob Cross, the Premier Lacrosse League Champion Coach of the PLL WaterDogs and previously at Harvard, UMBC, and Siena. As a player, he led the team in ground balls, assists by defensemen and hits and was awarded Team MVP, First Team All-Conference, Three-Year Captain, and six time Academic Honor Roll. Varsity Football won over Winter Springs on Friday 54-0 to improve to 8-1 on the season and stay unbeaten in the district. Both the Girls and Boys Cross Country Teams punched their ticket to the State Meet on Saturday in Gainesville! The entire Girls team contributed to the State qualifying effort, being led once again by Maya Cabal and Madalyn Falk, both with season best times. Personal records were set by Hannah Adamson and Hannah Atwell with Courtney Calhoun running close to her best time returning from injury. Loren Blumenfeld and Alyssa Wahl both contributed efforts close to their best times. While the Girls celebrated, the Boys team matched their performance. Led by Marc McDonald's season finishing 7th overall, the team also had personal records by Colin Aysun and Robert Bellamy as well as strong performances from Aiden Aysun, Brody Aysun, Myles Egerton and James Unwin who all helped the team advance.

The Boys & Girls Swim and Dive teams traveled to Ocala for the Region Championships and brought home the titles for on both sides, making them Region Champions! For the Girls, wins came from Marin Rose in the 200 Free with a 1:53 and the 500 Free with a 4:58. Sarah Beth Cathcart won the sprints with 23.6 in the 50 Free and 50.6 in the 100 Free. The Girls also won the 200 Free and the 400 Free Relays, boasting season best times by Sarah Beth Cathcart, Kaylin Herbet, Gabby Goodwin, Marin Rose, Ciel Senabria, and Nelle James. The Boys were led by Luca Oliva, who won both the 200 IM at 1:53 and the 500 Free at 4:35 and Carson Powers in Diving. Also, Thomas Youngblood, Ryan Walker, Lance Kochmann, and Daniel Strumidlo added victories in the 200 and the 400 Free Relays. The team will travel this weekend to the State Championship in Stuart, Florida.
