## Oviedo High School Safety and Security Priorities

### Administrative Priorities

Maintain a daily commitment to your duty station  
Interact with students while on duty to build student trust  
When absent, secure a substitute to man your duty station especially if it is a key area such as digital ID checks and/or the Commons  
Do daily bathroom sweeps and log bathroom sweeps in the Google doc  
Participate in monthly door checks and log door check feedback in the Google doc  
Follow up with teachers to make sure all doors are closed and locked  
Monitor the camera software and know how to use it  
Utilize the Net notification software when necessary  
If students do not have a pass, address it  
Know the safety procedures  
Practice code red drills in different roles  
Know how to use Raptor  
Know your role on the OHS safety team  
Participate in table top safety activities

### Faculty Priorities

Stand in doorway to greet students between classes  
Keep your classroom door locked at all times even if it is just you in the classroom  
Maintain a log for student exits and entrances out of your classroom  
Utilize school passes for all students  
Adhere to your classroom procedures regarding cell phones  
Adhere to the freeze time  
Ensure the practice of code red drills is taken seriously  
Ensure students know the code red drill procedures  
Know how to use Raptor

### Support Staff Priorities

Do not allow students in your area without an appropriate pass  
Help students in need and communicate with teachers if needed  
Ensure all visitors follow appropriate protocols  
If you see something, say something  
Know how to use Raptor  
For clerical with security camera access, immediately report anything suspicious

### Student Priorities

Follow classroom procedures for entering and exiting classrooms  
Do not open exterior doors for anyone  
Download and use your digital ID to enter campus after 7:20 a.m.  
If you see something, say something  
Know the safety procedures for fire drills and code red drills

### Family Priorities

Talk to your student about school safety and security  
Communicate with school staff about safety concerns  
Read emails and texts from school personnel and reach out with questions  
Remind your student to never open exterior doors for anyone  
If you see something, say something  
If you are dropping as student off late, please drop off at the front car ramp near the main office administration entrance

### Athletics from Athletic Director Jen Darty

Varsity Football won over University Orange City 35-7 to improve to 2-0 on the season. Senior running back DJ Scott had two touchdowns along with one touchdown each from junior Cameron Keels & Marquet Williams.

Girls Varsity Volleyball competed in the Nike Southeast Tournament of Champions. On Friday, the team won their pool defeating Fort Pierce Central 2-0, Bishop Verot 2-0, and Marvin Ridge (NC) 2-1. On Saturday, they lost to Osceola 1-2 and Olympia 1-2 before bouncing back and ending on a win over Pinecrest 2-0 to take 7<sup>th</sup> place overall. The team had strong play from

sophomores Anna Cathcart, Rylee Yarborough & Olivia Klimis along with junior Paige Wisneski and senior Lily Cammack.

Cross Country ran at the Deland Invitational. The Boys team took 3<sup>rd</sup> overall with Marc McDonald finishing 4<sup>th</sup>. The Girls team took 6<sup>th</sup> place overall, led by Hannah Adamson at 16<sup>th</sup>.

Boys Golf beat Lyman by 19 strokes at Mayfair. Freshman Caleb Anderson led all scorers followed by sophomore Tyler McGrath with the second best score of the day.

Bowling picked up two wins over Lake Brantley with the Boys winning 1983-1596 and the Girls winning 1505-1455. The Boys team was led by Adrian Maduro with the high game & high series followed by Zack Horrobin & Spencer Wainright. The Girls team was led by Emily Harvey with the high game & high series followed by Tayler Hennessy & Natalie Harvey.

Girls Volleyball won at all three levels over Lyman last night. The Freshmen team won in straight sets led by Sara Sobik & Jeweliet Jenkins. Junior Varsity also won 2-0, led by Meghan Maddox & Haley Kissane. The Varsity team completed the sweep, winning 3-0, led by junior Ella Maybin with 5 kills on 6 attempts & Jamie Kapoor with 3 aces and 4 blocks.

Swimming & Diving started their season strong with double wins over Lake Howell and Winter Springs. The Boys won 244-51 over Winter Springs and 237-88 over Lake Howell while the Girls won 250-81 over Winter Springs & 259-85 over Lake Howell. The Boys were led by senior Luca Oliva in the 200 IM 1:56 and the 100 Free 48.3. Other victories came from Daniel Strumidlo in the 200 and 500 Free, Thomas Youngblood won the 100 Fly with a 53, Lance Kochmann win the 100 Breast, and Simon Gong won the 100 Back. The Girls were led by double wins from Kaylin Herbet in the 50 Free and 100 Breast, Sara Beth Cathcart in the 100 Free and the 200 Free, and Diver Tessa Sims won with a 200.80. Other wins came from Marin Rose in the 500 Free, Gabby Goodwin in the 200 IM and freshman Addie Borowsky in the 100 Back.

Girls Bowling won over Hagerty 1714-1693 yesterday with Emily Harvey bowling the high game & high series followed by Natalie Harvey & Jenessa Leon. The Boys lost to Hagerty 2532-2198, led by Zack Horrobin with the high game & high series, followed by Adrian Maduro & Spencer Wainright.

Freshmen and JV Girls Volleyball split in their tri-match yesterday with both teams picking up wins over Timber Creek but falling to Winter Park. For JV, Trinity Gillispie & Aubrey Maybin led the team and for Freshmen, Phoebe Fletcher & Brylee Bell led.

Freshmen Football won 22-12 over Winter Springs last night. Bruce Slivinski threw two touchdowns. JV Football won over Lyman 60-27.
